**ADAPT** is a 30 week rolling group work programme for men who commit domestic abuse against their female partner. It aims to reduce domestic abuse and its damaging consequences by working with the perpetrators to change their behavior while supporting and empowering victims.

We are currently seeking staff for this new programme in Guernsey which has been commissioned as part of the Domestic Abuse Strategy for Guernsey and Alderney.

### **ADAPT COORDINATOR**

The ADAPT Coordinator will co-ordinate referrals and groups as well as undertake assessments. We are looking for someone with exceptional organisational, administrative and communication skills with an understanding of the issues surrounding domestic abuse, previous experience of working with the perpetrators, group work skills, management of staff along with a commitment to partnership working.

### **ADAPT WOMEN'S SAFETY WORKER**

This post fall under Section 7 (2) (f) of the Sex Discrimination (Employment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 2005 and, as such, invite applications from female applicants only.

The Women's Safety Worker will deliver a support service to women affected by domestic abuse whose (ex) partners are attending the ADAPT perpetrators programme. The role will link closely with the ADAPT coordinator to ensure effective risk management of every individual within ADAPT. Previous experience of working with women affected by domestic abuse and the ability to assess risk is crucial in this role.

These roles require a demonstrable commitment to the empowerment of service users as well as an appreciation of equal opportunity and diversity issues.

**Both positions are Part Time (18.75 hours per week) and are currently funded for a three year period**
